The feedback reflects a blend of opinions with many students appreciating the college's positive environment, the quality of teaching, and the development of skills, such as communication and personality growth. They feel the institution meets their needs well, and some even highlight it as the "best" without suggesting improvements.

Few felt that reducing the number of continuous classes and allow adequate breaks, minimizing burnout and giving students time for self-study and extracurricular activities. Adjust attendance policies to support students pursuing internships or other professional opportunities.

Others suggested that enhancing teacher-student interaction could further enrich the learning experience. There were suggestions that the institution should facilitate mandatory internships and field visits, allowing students to gain practical, real-world experience in their fields of study. Enhancing infrastructure could significantly improve the learning environment. Providing essential digital resources, like laptops to students would support their academic progress.
