Sacred garden was created with the intention of mapping the close relationship with trees and plants that have been held dear over the ages because of their uses in everyday life, religious and cultural significance.
- During the plantation and free distribution of saplings where large number of students and teachers participated.
- Tree saplings have been distributed to the staff and students of the college in the past.
- All the guests who visit the college during various functions are given plant saplings to perpetuate the habit of greening our surroundings.

CLEAN AND GREEN AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

- Many campaigns on ecological awareness have been conducted by eco club and other departments on 'Own a mug', creating plastic-free campus, water conservation, saving the tiger etc.
- Staff association encouraged green practices by distribution of reusable mugs and glass bottles to entire Gargi teaching staff.
- Also, under 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' a massive cleanliness drive was undertaken through posters and various other programmes in the college. Students were divided into groups and they personally cleaned every nook and corner of the college. Special attention went into ensuring cleanliness of areas like the canteen, library, toilets and the college lawns which are the favourite haunts of students and therefore more prone to littering.

Events organised by Avni:The Ecoclub in 2020-21

- Dr. Vandna Luthra in association with the Union members organized Plant-A-Veggie and Manure making activity. Students were engaged in growing vegetables of different kinds in waste containers and shared their growth on a periodic basis. They enthusiastically named their plants and shared their experiences with the fellow participants. All the photographs, experiences were shared by them on a common google sheet. A Virtual eco-initiative kept the motivation high during the testing times of Covid which was truly enjoyed by the students.
- Our social media platforms also regularly featured activities, namely “Eco Trivia,” “Soothing Sundays”, “Monday eco-meme” which promote collective learning and expression.
- Open discussion forums, called “Eco-Baithak,” were organized regularly to initiate conversation and expression and to provide a sense of belonging to all. Many topics like plastics, effects of microplastics, green Diwali, reflection of the Plant-A-Veggie and composting were discussed in these.
- In addition to planting saplings and making manure, some of the activities involved making handmade paper by recycling waste paper, doing things that gave us peace, cooking a zero-waste meal at home and reducing screen time.

Some details of the Plant-A-Veggie and Composting Initiative during the pandemic

Guidelines

1. Arrange a pot or recyclable container
2. Arrange the soil and other ingredients
3. Work on the nature of seeds you wish to choose for
4. Give a name to your plant
5. Take 1-2 photographs at different stages
6. Send the weekly report/ photos by inserting against your name.

- 80 students from a multitude of subjects participated
- 14 different varieties of vegetables and plants were grown
- Students submitted photos and accompanying comments
- detailing how well their plants have grown

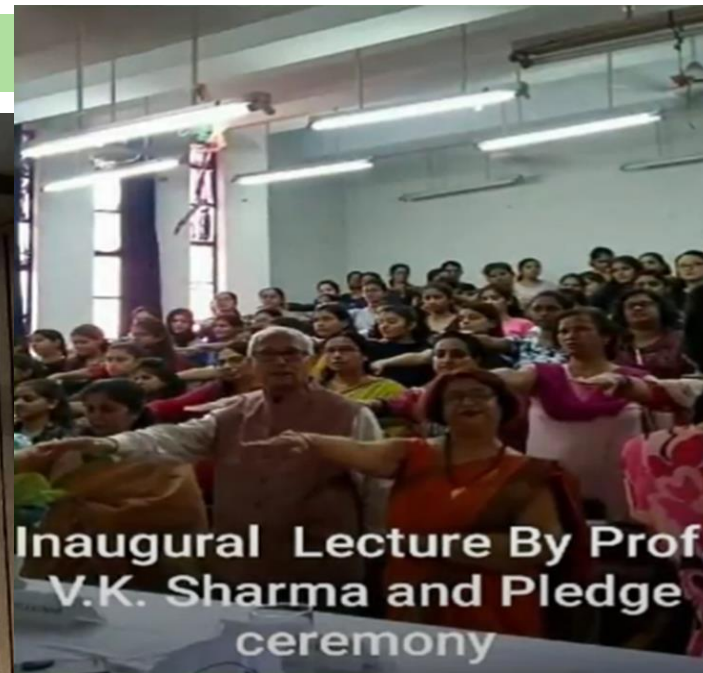
Events organised by Avni:The Ecoclub in 2018-19
