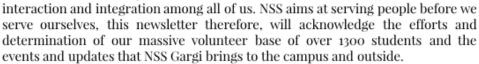

Hence, following the motto of NSS, i.e., 'NOT ME BUT YOU', the NSS Gargi Students' Union 2019–20 organized a stream of events marking the start of the session 2019–20.

1. Independence Day: 15th August, 2019

Independence Day, as always, was celebrated in Gargi College with great pomp and show. It's a day to remember the service oriented people who had lost lives due to their spirit of giving back to the society and helping others instead of thinking about themselves during the freedom struggle. The event started with a remarkable 'Squad Drill' by the NCC cadets of Gargi College. 2. Donation Drives: 14th-16th & 29th August, 2019

After enough supplies were collected, dates were decided and volunteers were appointed for the final dates. The students went around the **IIT flyover** and the slums near **Hauz Khas** to distribute dry eatables.
