PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

2000-2001

Hon'ble Chief Guest Shri Karan Thapar, respected Director, South Campus, Professor Deepak Pental, esteemed Chairman, Dr.Ratnakar Pandey, Members of the Governing Council, dear colleagues and friends,

We are assembled here to celebrate the 34th Annual Day of Gargi College. I have the pleasure and privilege to welcome you all to this function, which marks the high-point of our year-long academic, cultural, and co-curricular activities for the year 2000-2001.

It is indeed a matter of great pride for all of us at Gargi to have such distinguished persons on the dais. Shri Karan Thapar needs no introduction. We have all had the pleasure of seeing him and listening to his incisive, enjoyable and witty talkshows and comments on the TV screen. Today we have the honour of receiving him here and listening to him in person. Shri Karan Thapar represents one of the keenest and sharpest intellects of our country. His achievements are prodigious. He is a writer, correspondent, journalist, freelance writer, book reviewer, editor and above all a presenter, director and producer of news and current affairs and other interview based programmes on the television. A double tripos from Cambridge in Economics and Social sciences, Shri Karan Thapar started his career as a journalist before moving onto the small screen. He has been bestowed many awardschief among them are the Shell UK Television Certificate of Merit award for his Weekend World's Programme The Big Bang, the Award of Merit from British Association of Film and Television Arts, the Videocon Screen award for the Best Current Affairs Anchor, the Onida Pinnacle award for the Best Chatshow Anchor and the Asian Television award for the Best Current Affairs Anchor. On behalf of my faculty, students and staff, I extend a warm welcome to you and thank you for accepting our invitation to be the Chief Guest at today's function.

We are equally privileged to have with us **Professor Deepak Pental**, Director, South Campus. I had not met Professor Pental till six months ago .I met him for the first time after he was appointed Director. Within a few minutes of talking to him, I developed a very strong and decided feeling that Professor Pental was the person Delhi University had been waiting for-one with a rare blend of a powerful scientific mind, good administrative skills and a harmonious fusion of moral and intellectual virtues, who has a definitive vision of the direction Delhi University has to take to better its image as a centre of excellence. I thank you, Professor Pental for acceding to our request to be our special guest and also preside over today's function.

We are grateful to our chairman, **Dr. Ratnakar Pandey** for being with us here today. As Chairman of our Governing Council, he has displayed true statesman-like qualities in helping us to develop the college. The recogni-

tion of the virtues of a refined mind, of an enlightened thinker and a cultured human being has been one of the primary benefits I have personally received from my association with him. I thank Dr.Ratnakar Pandey and all the other members of our management who have been a source of strength and support in all our endeavours to make this college a leading institution of excellence.

Higher education has always been intertwined with the notion of college and collegiate life. Over the last so many years, Delhi University colleges have evolved in many different ways, in responding to the needs of the time and the needs of the society. We, at Gargi, have also re-positioned ourselves to meet the challenges of our times. But at the same time, we have continued to cherish the traditional ideal which had shaped higher education in the past- the ideal of the college as an actual place where academic life and community life coalesce, where each assumes a measure of equal importance. Conscious of the current demands of the society that calls for the jobworthiness of any university degree we have recognised four fundamental functions:

- to offer general academic courses;
- to introduce students to academic specialisation;
- to provide pre-professional training; and
- to promote a civilising function.

The first two functions form the basis of the education offered here. We offer courses in Arts, Humanities, Sciences and Commerce besides Bachelors degree courses in Elementary Education and Industrial Microbiology. Our cent percent results bear out the excellence in our teaching and training. Tomorrow at the convocation of Delhi University four of my students are to receive awards for topping the final year examinations held in April 2000. Ms. Mudita Mohile has been awarded the All India Post Graduate Scholarship 2000-2001 for pursuing Master's degree in English. We have also secured 42 positions in the university examinations in the South Campus. The Roll of Honour of our meritorious achievers is given in the later pages of this report. Our congratulations to all these students who have done proud by our college.

There is a proverb in Tamil which says: "You can ladle the soup only out of a full pot and not from an empty one." Such excellent results cannot be had if the faculty lacks the quality of excellence. I am proud to head an institution where quality learning is matched by quality teaching. My faculty members in a large majority are committed to the twin demands of their profession-teaching and research.

A brief glance at the listing of the achievements of our teachers is proof of the continuing process of learning and teaching at the faculty level. Our congratulations to Dr. Minoti Chatterjee (Department of Political Science) and Dr. Pragati Ashdhir (Department of Physics) on their being awarded Ph.D by the University of Delhi.

It is also a matter of pride for us that 17 of our teachers went on a visit to the Centre for Environment Education at Ahmedabad to get a first hand experience of promoting Environment Education at the latter's invitation. These teachers have contributed articles to a book **The Seed Within**, a Gargi publication, which will be released today by Professor Pental. These articles describe the teachers' individual response to environment education through their respective disciplines. The visit to Ahmedabad and the publication have had the academic and financial support of the college.

As teaching assumes a greater role in the delivery of online education, our teachers, not desiring to be left behind went for a special training in computer literacy at the NIIT centre within our premises. I thank the NIIT for giving this training free of charge to 80 of our teachers.

The college had organised a special workshop on Learning About Computers for our laboratory staff, to generate computer literacy and awareness amongst them. This was greatly valued and encouraged by the Centre for Science Education and Communication, Delhi University which provided the financial support.

One of the significant areas where our College has taken the lead is to extend the frontiers of education beyond the classroom. Every year we organise a major National/International seminar and an inter-college seminar in one or two departments. This time it was the turn of the Department of Elementary Education to organise a National seminar on Alternatives in Education: In Search of a New Paradigm. The papers presented during the seminar by eminent educationists from all over India will be shortly brought out. We could not get them ready for release today as we are still awaiting a few more papers presented on the occasion. We are thankful to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, University Grants Commission and the Aga Khan Foundation for their generous financial support- a proof of the importance and significance of the area covered by this seminar.

The Department of Commerce organised a major seminar on *Convergence: The New Mantra*. The keynote address was given by Hon'ble Minister Arun Jaitley and the other distinguished speakers included Shri.Rajdeep Sardesai, Shri Siddharth Basu and Professor P.N.Varshney.

The Department of Philosophy had a one-day seminar on *It is Unjust to Treat Unequals Equally* addressed by Professor D.P.Chattopadhyaya, Professor Andre Beteille, Dr.Madhu Kishwar and Shri L.M.Singhvi.All other seminars and academic lectures are listed in the later pages of this report.

Returning to the third of the basic functions that I had enumerated earlier, i.e. to provide pre-professional training, the college had been doing splendid work towards achieving this. This is in keeping with our objective to give

professional competency to students while they pursue their studies for a first degree.

19 of our Hindi Honours students underwent special training in Media presentation at the Amal Allana's newly instituted centre DADA to enable them to move onto anchoring and newsreading in Hindi on Radio and Television. The college has started a Film society *Glass I* to screen quality films and educate students in Film Appreciation. We are proud that we were the first in India to screen a retrospective of Ritwik Ghatak's films in the college, which was open to students and the public. We have had other courses in Art Appreciation, Western Classical Music Appreciation and Environmental Education. This year we have opened a Gargi-Tata Infotech Centre in the college to provide computer education to Gargi students at one-third of the fees charged elsewhere.

It has been our endeavour to build our students as future leaders of a civilised society-the fourth function listed above. Those who are enrolled with us for a post-secondary education get the benefits of holistic learning through an active campus that provides rich cultural fare. I compliment our dynamic Students' Union, led by Ms. Ravina Dhupar, which had organised these cultural programmes featuring eminent classical dancers, and musicians which include Smt.Shovana Narain, Smt.Geeta Chandran, Smt. Madhvi Mudhgal, Smt. Bharati Shivaji, Aman Ali Bangash and Ayan Ali Bangash and today's artist Professor Debu Chaudhuri. The inter-college festival Reverie was a resounding success with many of the leading colleges participating in it. From this year onwards we have introduced inter-cultural meetings, inviting colleges to present a play or choreography events for our students. This is meant to bring about closer interaction among students through cultural activities and thereby encourage real talent amongst our youth. The Gargi College Dramatic Society, Upstage has won prizes and recognition at different festivals .The National Commission for Women commissioned the college group to perform a play Covenant With Death for its 10th Founders Day celebrations. The NCW had also organised 16 workshops in the college on specific issues ranging from gender equality, social justice, interpersonal relations, communication to crisis management for the empowerment of Women.

The Gargi Extension Service unit of the college deserves special mention for the splendid work it has done throughout the year. Besides the annual hosting of special functions for the Senior Citizens and organising blood donation camp, the Gargi Extension Service with the Department of Microbiology and the First Aid Wing organised Hepatitis B vaccination camps for the students, faculty members and staff of the college. It provided free vaccine to the staff of Gargi .We are thankful to Wockhardt company for giving us the vaccines at subsided price. The GES has also done great service to the Gujarat victims of the recent earthquake reaching them supplies of food and medicine on the very next day after the disaster.

The different academic societies, the GES, NSO, NCC and the Students' Union have worked hard to realise our objective of extending the quality of education beyond the classrooms.

A monthly Newsletter **Oracle** was started for the students, by the students to initiate interaction amongst different departments and to also inform them about various forthcoming events in the college.

Fataristic Vision

We do not wish to rest on our achievements. The notion of evolution is critical to any institution. The key to extending the benefits of collegiate education in the future is to recognise the importance of continuous evolution and the need for continuous re-assessment and re-examination of all our activities and strategies. The collegiate ideal originates not because of internal demands, but due to outside changes brought about by new student characteristics, complex societal needs, new technologies and last but not the least the problem of unclear purpose. There is growing criticism that the universities and colleges lack clear purpose.

The noted educationist, Stanley Ikenberry says: "Ultimately, the crucial challenge facing colleges and universities is not so much cost or technology, as profound as these may be, but the challenge of purpose: the demand to define and clarify why we exist: what it is we do best: what it is that we care about most... If the purpose of the campus is the creation of students and scholars who accomplish important things that are highly valued by the society, survival is not an issue. ... If higher education has to do only with gaining access to information, acquiring employable skills, and gaining certification of competence, then campuses indeed are at risk".

We are on the move towards realising the collegiate ideal of clear purpose, of maximising human interactions, of integrating academic studies and experiential learning and setting high expectations. I would like to end this report on a quote from Rg Veda:

Meet together, talk together
May your minds comprehend alike:
Common be your action and achievement
Common be your thoughts and intention
Common be the wishes of your hearts
-so there may be thorough union among you.
This would be the guiding principle for both our faculty and students.
