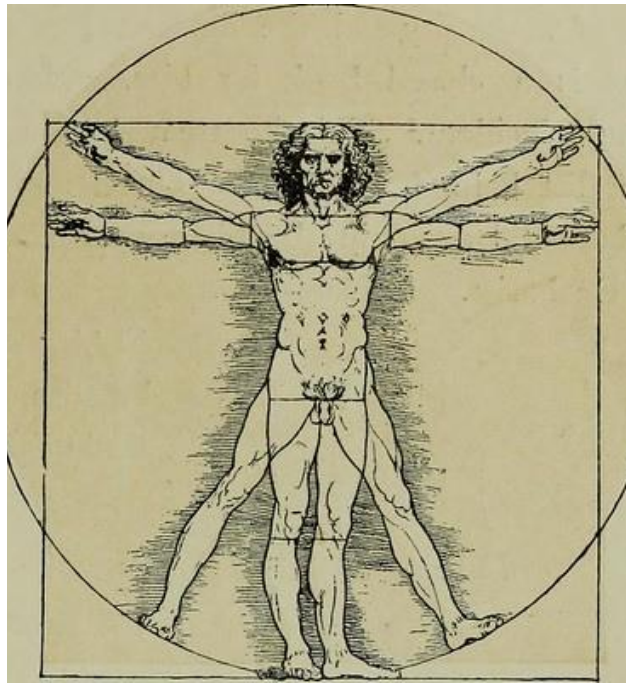


## ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

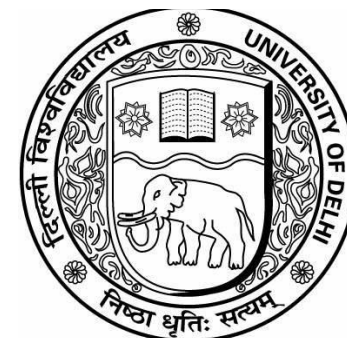

# POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

## THEMES OF E-POSTER PRESENTATION

- Neurobiology
- Neural Disorders
- Treatment of Neural Disorders

Poster abstract to be submitted in the prescribed format by **10**

**September 2020:**

- Running Title (Times New Roman, font 14)
- Full names of author and Co-authors
- Presenting author name should be underlined
- Presenting author<sup>1</sup>, Co-authors<sup>1</sup>  
Corresponding author<sup>1\*</sup> (Times New Roman font 12), Affiliations<sup>1</sup> (Times New Roman font 12)
- Abstract 250–300 words (Times New Roman 12)

## POSTER SIZE AND ORIENTATION

- All posters should be in portrait format. All information (i.e. text, data, photos, and figures) must be designed to appear within one window/slide of poster.
- If you design your E-poster in powerpoint (.ppt), ALL information must appear within ONE slide only. Use page set-up and choose slide size: “Custom (Width 50 cm, Height 90 cm)” with a Portrait (vertical) orientation.
- Save your PPT into PDF format (size limit of pdf file 10 MB)

## ESSENTIAL INFORMATION TO INCLUDE IN E-POSTER

- Content of poster presentation (ONLY Original research work allowed or original research proposal idea)
- Research work (Introduction, Objectives, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusion, References and Acknowledgment)
- Research Idea (Background, Original Hypothesis, Future Direction, References and Acknowledgment)
- The title and subheadings should be written in bold. Multiple fonts should be avoided. Poster Font Size: 16 or more
- At the footer/Bottom part of poster presentation, should be noted: Presented at: International E-conference “NeuroEunoia 2020: A Neuroscience Affair”



# POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

## SUBMISSION OF E-POSTER (PDF FORMAT ONLY)

- The deadline for E-poster submission is 20 September 2020.
- A short video clip (.mp4 or .avi) explaining the poster (not more than 2 minutes) should accompany the E-poster
- All the entries to be sent at [neuroeunoia2020@gmail.com](mailto:neuroeunoia2020@gmail.com) BEFORE 11:59 pm on 20 September 2020.

- Kindly note that selecting any one theme out of the above is mandatory
- One person can only submit one poster
- Submission of video to explain your work is compulsory (in present screen mode, preferably)
- The name of the presenting author should be underlined and only one certificate will be issued per poster presentation, on the name of the presenting author

- Abstract submission deadline for poster presentation: 10 September 2020
