
Gladioli have a unique long and pointed shape. Because of their shape, they are named after the Latin word "gladius", meaning sword. In Rome, gladioli were associated with gladiators.

Because of their association with gladiators, the gladiolus flower meaning is strength and integrity. Hence, it symbolises beauty, strength and honour, much like a woman.

In the logo, it is held like a sword by number 8.

Number 8 reflects balance, it ignites our soul as the cyclic path of breath moving through our lungs and body is in an 8-like pattern (infinite number).

Number 8 is the highest feminine number.









UNITEDAGAINSTSLAVERY
